## Cell Phone Responsibility Agreement*

## Normal Use

## Safety

I will answer my phone when my parent calls.

$\square$ I will tell my parents if I am being harassed by someone on my cell phone.
$\square$ I will not harass or bully anyone with my cell phone.
$\square$ I will not use my cell phone to arrange meetings with anyone my parents don't know.

## Texting

I will not send threatening or mean texts to others.
$\square$ I will not send or take embarrassing photos of myself, my family or my friends.
$\square$ I will not share photos with other people in a way that hurts their reputation.
$\square$ I will not forward a hurtful message or picture sent to me about someone else.

## Being Polite

I will not bring my cellphone anywhere that my parents prohibit its use, like the family dinner table.
I will not be rude to others by talking to texting in public places where cell phone use in not aloud or is inappropriate, like in a church or library.
I will follow all school rules about cell phone use.

The following are reasonable consequences if any of the above rules are broken.

I understand that having a cell phone is a privilege that can be taken away.
I understand this agreement will help me to demonstrate responsible behaviour.
I understand my parents reward good behaviour with more freedom.
I understand there are consequences for breaking this agreement.
